Additional changes have been more State initiated with the creation of a new program, the Employment and Community First Waiver which is entirely focused on employment and community inclusion for new individuals entering the service system. In addition to our 48 years of service to adults with intellectual disabilities Dawn of Hope will also begin to explore additional service opportunities to other populations in our service area. As we continue to look forward by encompassing these new changes and new opportunities, we will always be committed to providing high quality, caring and individualized services to enrich the lives of the people we serve.
