What We Do—What You Do!

A LETTER FROM EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR LEE CHASE

t's been a tough spring this year with the Tennessee General Assembly facing the difficult task of deciding what departments, programs, or jobs to cut in order to balance the budget.

Regarding funding reductions to the Division of Intellectual Disability Services, Lt. Governor Ron Ramsey stated last fall that "we've cut about as much as we can cut. . . . If there is a legitimate reason for government to exist it's to help those that can't help themselves."

His remarks are very true. However, Tennessee community programs like Dawn of Hope are slated for about \$35 million in reductions effective June 30, with the loss of stimulus/recovery funds. On the table this year in Governor Bredesen's budget are some \$53 million in further proposed reductions, with the final outcome to be determined.

What does this all mean? Last week I was called by the father of a 27-year-old man who had been cared for at home since injury in a car accident at age 17. The family was seeking residential services due to their physical inability to continue the total care their son required. When I told the father that we could help—he just broke down and said "Praise God for you and your organization." Through my own tears I replied "That's what we're here to do."

That is what we do—enriching the lives of those with intellectual disabilities (and their families). But what you do is so important. Thank you for all the support you provide to the Dawn of Hope Foundation through our fund raising efforts—our recent Spring Luau which raised a record \$43,000, and our upcoming Golf Classic in August. Yes we do—but we couldn't do without you.

We've enclosed a form and giving envelope for the Golf Classic . We welcome you to be a player, a sponsor or a donor. All proceeds from the tournament will help provide new programs as well as improve existing programs for those we serve at Dawn of Hope. Programs are the lifeblood of this agency as they offer continuing education and creative opportunities—two things we all need but are crucial for those with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Thank you in advance for financially supporting the Golf Classic and helping us continue to improve lives at Dawn of Hope.




