

How do you say good-bye to a dear friend? How do you convey all they have meant to you throughout their lifetime? I first came to know Tim Jones while working with his wife Valda, who served as a member of our Board of Directors. During our Capital Campaign to raise \$1 million for the Stratton Building, with Valda as chair, I began to see the high caliber of a man Tim truly was. Tim graciously helped to coordinate meetings with important business individuals such as Scott Niswonger and the late Congressman Jimmy Quillen. Tim even pulled in other members of his immediate family to help Dawn of Hope reach our very ambitious Capital Campaign goal. We did reach that goal—with much credit to Tim.

Then there was the time Dawn of Hope was faced with the challenge of obtaining a clear building title from the State on our former location on Millard Street. How was it solved? Tim met with the Governor and, within a matter of days, the obstacle was removed and our path to the Stratton Building was cleared.

Then there were the golf tournaments. Tim led the tournament committee for a number of years, and helped implement a more effective format of the tournament. This year's 25th Anniversary Dawn of Hope Golf Classic was a milestone event and was named as tribute to Tim's memory.

There is no question that Tim and Valda had a beautiful relationship. Tim gave his time and resources to so many organizations that helped others, and was also incredibly active in community development to improve the quality of life for all in Johnson City. Tim will be missed very much, and by so many.

It's really impossible to say good-bye, but we sincerely want to convey to Tim's memory our utmost thanks and heart-felt appreciation for so many years of irrevocable dedication and support of the Dawn of Hope and the impact his efforts continue to make on the recipients we serve. We have known few friends that have been so committed.






