New Ventures

Dawn of Hope was recently selected for participation in the new Medicaid Wavier coming to Tennessee – the Employment Community First (or ECF Waiver). This wavier is slated to replace existing waivers for any new incoming service recipients after July 1, 2016 - [a wavier is a federal funding mechanism].



The new wavier is specifically designed to address the services noted in the name – Employment and Community FIRST, meaning that all enrollees will focus on employment services as a primary day service. Those unable to participate in employment due to desire or disability will be required to have a community day service rather than a facility based day service.

The focus for the intellectually disabled enrollees will be three groups – Those exiting or have recently exited high school who have a desire to be employed; those adult children of aging caregivers (parents who are aged 75 and older) and have an adult child with an intellectual disability residing with them; and lastly, intellectually disabled individuals that meet the definition of “crisis” (homeless with no one to provide care). It is being anticipated that approximately 1,700 people will be served in the upcoming fiscal year.

Dawn of Hope is honored to have been selected to participate in the new Employment and Community First Waiver by both of the Managed Care Organizations (MCOs); Blue Care and Amerigroup, who are administering the program. United Health Care is expected to join them in January 2017. Only 25-30 providers were selected in the state to participate in this waiver. Participation will allow Dawn of Hope to continue serving new individuals under this waiver as admission to the three existing waivers will cease June 30, 2016. It will also allow Dawn of Hope to focus on individuals who wish to obtain community employment, a service which Dawn of Hope has provided since 1988. We anxiously await beginning these new – but familiar services.

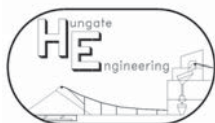
